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## **Reading**

Every child will be issued with a reading book which must be in school every day. The expectation for reading at home is four times a week, which we know can sometimes be difficult. For the more able readers, we encourage independent reading, and ask that an adult questions their child on what they have read before signing the reading record. If reading at home is a problem for any reason, then please speak to the class teacher.

Year 5 will visit the school library on a Monday and will be able to borrow one book, which can come home. Should your child wish to change their book, they must ensure it is in school for Monday.
