


Dear Parents,

Loving Geography Learning

Already this term, our children have brought geography to life through hands-on fieldwork. Poppy Class have drawn their own route maps before setting off into town next week. Year 3 have been identifying key landmarks, physical and human feature in Bude. Year 4 refined their use and understanding of grid references and map symbols, through beautiful scale drawings of the Neet and Tamar in readiness for their fieldwork trip to the former and their boat trip up the River Tamar to the latter. Year 5 investigated Arctic and Antarctic land loss, using real-world data and case studies to understand the impact of climate change on fragile ecosystems. Year 6 have now designed unique biomes inspired by their recent visit to St Nectan's Glen, drawing on their knowledge of biodiversity, climate, and adaptation to create well-researched, imaginative and fabulous habitats. 


