Autumn 2 curriculum overview

In maths the children will be learning about measurement (g, kg, mm, cm, m, km, ml, l), area, division and multiplication. PE days

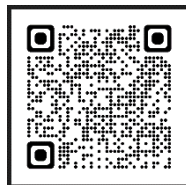
Monday (Netball) and Tuesday (Tag Rugby)
