

Year 5 | Summer 2 | 2024

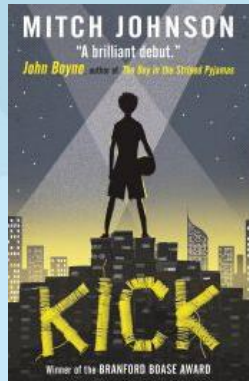
Enquiry: The winds of change- identify and evaluate sustainable energy installations.
