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Reminder, Absences

If your child is absent from school, please let the office know before 9am. You can leave an answerphone message, send an email to hello@budejuniors.org.uk or telephone the office 01288 352731.

Please give full details to why your child is absent, "not well" or "not feeling well" or "not in" is not a reason that we can use on our registers. For example, is it a sickness bug, tummy upset, severe cold/flu, bad tooth ache or covid symptoms? The office will have to contact you if this is not clear.

If they are feeling a little under the weather, please send them in and let us know so we can keep an eye on them. Please try and make medical appointments for your child outside of school hours.

If you consider an absence during term time to be an exceptional circumstance, please complete a form and return it to the school office at least 15 days before the date you wish to take your child out of school. This includes holidays.

Being in school every day that it is open, is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and their wider development.

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
