Value: Democracy

History - The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain
The children will develop an understanding of what an empire is.

Children will apply their knowledge of chronology from earlier units and consider prior knowledge about life in Iron Age Britain and the settlement of indigenous groups. They will then expand their chronological understanding to the founding of Rome, the expansion of Roman rule and significant Emperors.

Look at animators and create characters to use in computing.

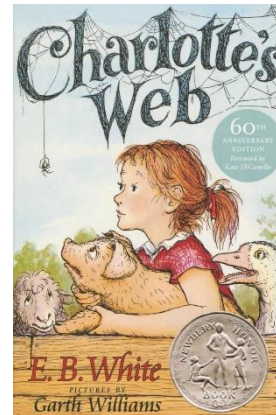
